NuYu Teeth Whitening is one of the newest, quickest, safest, and most effective teeth whitening systems available outside of a dental office. NuYu Teeth Whitening is guaranteed to rapidly produce a noticeably brighter and whiter smile. NuYu Teeth Whitening is one of the only processes currently available that will give you such dramatic results in a very short time in an easy, convenient process without a dentist or dentist price.

NuYu Teeth Whitening pen can be purchased separately to help maintain and improve teeth whiteness when used regularly and as directed.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Most people with healthy teeth and gums will experience no discomfort during the NuYu Teeth Whitening process. A tingling or slight sensitivity is normal and not harmful to your gums or enamel. Occasionally, gum or lip discomfort is experienced by particularly sensitive individuals. To prevent this, lightly coat the affected areas with Vitamin E. For teeth sensitivity it is best to use a Potassium Nitrate/Fluoride mix such as Sensodyne tooth paste. Following the treatment for those individuals who have sensitive teeth and or gums, it should subside within 24 hours.

MINOR BLANCHING OF THE GUMS & INFO

This is a temporary reaction to the whitening process and is not harmful to your teeth or gums, and will disappear, usually in less than 30 minutes.

If you have tooth decay, significant enamel demineralization, periodontal (gum) disease, irritation or bleeding gums, have not been seen by a dentist recently; you should not engage the NuYu Teeth Whitening process until these conditions have been successfully resolved by a dentist.

It is true that your teeth will never be whiter than they were when you received your permanent teeth when you were a child. Different individuals have different natural tooth color. No whitening process will get your teeth whiter then their "new" color. As good as NuYu Teeth Whitening is, it (along with any other teeth whitening process) cannot alter your genetic traits.

NuYu Teeth Whitening works on the natural tooth structure only. If you have veneers, composite (white) fillings, implants or other synthetic tooth structures or enhancements, they will not be affected by the whitening process. The color of these structures will remain as they were when installed. However, it possible to have your teeth whitened and then meet with your dentist to match the shades of your veneers, composite (white) fillings, implants or other synthetic tooth structures or enhancements.

AFTER CARE AND FOLLOW UP

For a minimum of 24 hours after the process, avoid consuming coffee, tea, dark colored soda, red wine, berries, candy, red sauces, beets, chocolate or any other foods that have a propensity to stain your teeth. A good guideline is, if it stains a white shirt, it will stain your teeth. Of course, brush and floss as directed by your dentist.

There is no definite answer as to how long the whitening effect will last; this is highly dependent on many individual factors, including the current condition and age of your teeth, diet, alcohol and tobacco consumption, genetics and dental, general and periodontal health. Whitening Specialist onsite will suggest follow up whitening sessions if necessary. The use of whitening pen 3 times after your first whitening treatment has been shown to help blend, brighten, and maintain the smile longer.

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
